


The Problem

Community size ~1200 people


Aim to resettle ~20% of current pop

Sufficient land area for basic needs

What might it look like at scale?


Land per person 3.15ha

Assumes low meat diet



Land required per person

Inversion of population density: ha/person



Land required per village

1200 people on 3600 ha

Compare with Cleveland + Redlands population ~ 35,000



Or Emerald hinterland?

Decentraliased settlement area for 1.1M people
